Song: O Blood and Water, which gushed forth from the Heart of Jesus, as a fount of mercy for us, I trust in You! (3x)

NB. You may choose pray to Jesus with simple words from your heart or to stay in silence, standing spiritually on Calvary gazing with love upon Jesus giving His life for us.

The important thing about prayer at the Hour of Mercy 3PM, is that it is addressed to Jesus on the Cross, not to the Father or to Mary or to St. Faustina or some other saint. It is Jesus who is dying at 3 PM out of love for us. It is Jesus who wants that we immerse ourselves in His Passion at 3 PM.

*3 PM - Meditation addressed to Jesus

You are the Messiah, the Son of the living God (Mt. 16: 16). Master, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life. We have come to believe and are convinced that you are the Holy One of God. (Jn. 6: 68–69).

Merciful Jesus, at the moment of your death we stand at the foot of the Cross. We want to profess together with St. Peter that *You are the Messiah, the Son of the living God* (Mt. 16: 16). *Master, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life* (Jn. 6: 68). You are the Son of the living God, the fairest of the sons of men, even though Your beauty and majesty is hidden under the mantle of suffering. Stretched out on the cross, You have no majestic bearing to catch our eye, no beauty to draw us to You. You are spurned and avoided by men, counted as a villain; You are a man of suffering, knowing pain, like one from whom people turn their face, spurned and held in no esteem (cf. Is. 53:2-3). And yet, You are the Messiah, the Son of the living God, who was crushed for our iniquity. Only in You is life found, and in Your wounds our healing.

Today, we give You thanks, Lord Jesus, for having given us the *words of eternal life* and for confirming them by Your sacrifice on the Cross. For this we thank You. We immerse in the depths of Your mercy the Holy Church, the whole world especially the suffering nations of Syria, Belarus and Lebanon. By the merits of Your sorrowful Passion, we beg You for the grace of conversion, especially for souls whose salvation is most endangered. May every person enjoy their natural and supernatural life, and praise Your mercy.
