

GOSPEL: (Mt 28: 16-20)

ST. FAUSTINA NOTED IN HER DIARY (D. 1767, 949, 1129, 1804)

Though at certain times, you may not feel My presence, I shall be by your side. Fear not, My grace shall be with you...
